How to Prepare Your Home for Spring

IN THE GARDEN

- Turn on irrigation system, check sprinkler heads and drip lines for proper function
- Trim larger, overgrown hedges in early spring
- Remove any debris and turn your soil over to prepare for planting—2 to 4 weeks before planting
- ♦ Have a game plan on what you want to plant, when to order and which plants take longer to grow
- Have pool equipment inspected and prepare to open that pool

AROUND THE HOUSE

- Remove leaves and debris from gutters
- Power wash windows and siding
- Check all weather stripping and caulking around your doors & windows, replace if needed.
- Clean all window and door screens
- ♦ Have air conditioning unit serviced
- Refinish the deck
- Have septic tank inspected and pumped if necessary
- Examine roof shingles for any damage or missing shingles
- Check stucco and concrete for any larger cracks that need attention

INSIDE THE HOUSE

- Clean Garbage Disposal—fill with ice and run water while disposal is on, maybe a couple of times
- Vacuum heat registers and vents
- Vacuum bathroom fan vents
- Check all smoke and carbon monoxide alarms, replace batteries if needed
- Reverse your fans—if they turn counter clockwise, they'll circulate the cooler air
- Clean your carpets
- Vacuum lint from the dryer vent and clean venting tube
- Change your air filters
- Drain and flush water heater
